

Hall Photography Competition 2018/2019

The competition is open to all members of the Hall Community. This is not a professional photography competition – anyone with any kind of camera is encouraged to enter and there are prizes to be won!

This year there will be no separate categories, we would just like to see photographs of your experiences of Hall life! From the much-photographed stylised Front Quad photo, to quirky images of architectural details, to images of one of the Hall sports teams in action, or a Hall bop in full flow. Feel free to send in both old and new photographs of the Hall.

You can submit up to five photographs and the prizes awarded will be:

First place: £150

Second place: £75

Third place: £50

How to enter

- Pictures should be submitted by email to aularianconnect@seh.ox.ac.uk
- Emailed pictures should be between 1MB and 3MB (1200x900 pixels to 2048x1536 pixels).
- Each picture should be clearly labelled with photographer name, category, title, location, names of subjects (if applicable) and may include an optional description.
- Along with your submission you must provide your name, matriculation year, telephone number and email details. St Edmund Hall will not publish them or provide them to anyone without your permission.
- A maximum of five entries will be accepted per person.
- If your photograph features any recognisable person or people, written permission should be obtained for the image to be entered in the competition and to be published online and in all media as required.
- Results will be posted on the St Edmund Hall website once term has finished.

Closing Date

- Deadline for receiving entries is Wednesday 1 May 2019.

Photography Showcase

- Winning photographs will be displayed at the 2020 St Edmund Hall Artweeks Exhibition.
- By submitting your photograph to St Edmund Hall you agree to grant St Edmund Hall, free of charge, the right to publish and the right to license others to publish the photograph online and in all media as required.

- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

- You must supply full details as required above, and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prize(s). No responsibility is accepted for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently.
- By submitting your photograph to St Edmund Hall you agree to your name being published in relation to your photograph online and in all media.
- Your entry must be entirely your own original work, not defame anybody nor breach any copyright.
