How we use your data

The personal data you provide on this form/the enclosed reply card will be used to fulfil St Edmund Hall's contractual obligation to you as an event registrant. We will use your data to: organise and implement the event; make any reasonable adjustments to improve the service offered to you during the event; communicate news and updates about the event; thank you for your attendance; send you materials from the event; and request your feedback following the event. Where you have provided

consent, we may store sensitive data for future events, such as your dietary or mobility requirements. We also store and share your data to meet our legitimate interests of alumni and supporter engagement, fundraising and stewardship which may include, a record of your attendance at this event and updates to your contact details and communication preferences. Where your inclusion in a photograph constitutes personal data, we will seek your consent prior to using it in marketing or promotional materials.

Who has access to your data

The data you provide will be stored and shared across the collegiate University of Oxford, including with its relevant clubs and societies if appropriate, in accordance with the University's policies and procedures via our shared relationship management system. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data at any time. The University and participating colleges are both "data controllers", meaning you can contact either the University or your college if you have questions about your data.

We may also need to share your data with third parties supporting the delivery of the event (e.g. mailing houses, printers, event management platforms, venues, caterers). We only share your data with third parties in appropriate circumstances, for specified purposes, by secure means, and with the relevant data sharing

agreements in place. We do not and will not sell your data. For events held outside the European Economic area, we may transfer your data to third parties outside the EU as part of our contractual obligation, only where we have approved contractual clauses in place.

How long we keep your data

We consider our relationship with our alumni, donors and supporters to be lifelong and we will retain most of your data indefinitely unless you request otherwise.

Your rights

You have the right to opt-out of direct marketing at any time. You also have the rights to request access to and correction or erasure of your data; to request transfer of your data to another party; or to object to the processing of your data or request that such processing is restricted.
