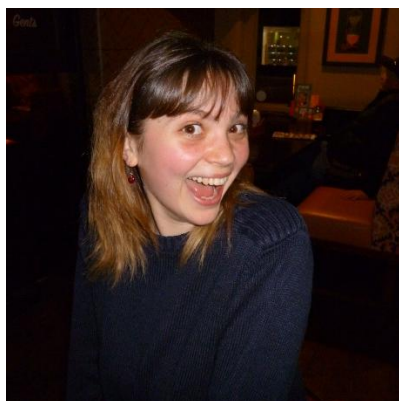

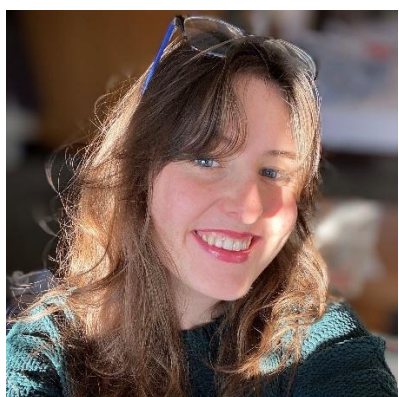
I'm a second-year experimental psychologist. I enjoy playing violin, and play for the university string ensemble. I'm always happy to have a chat if needed!

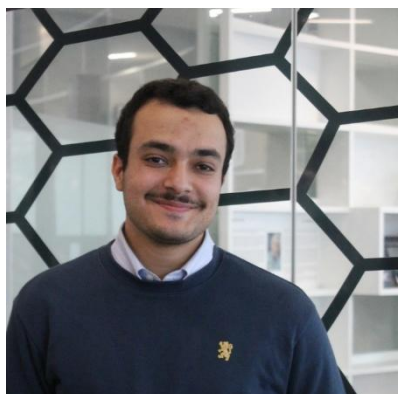
