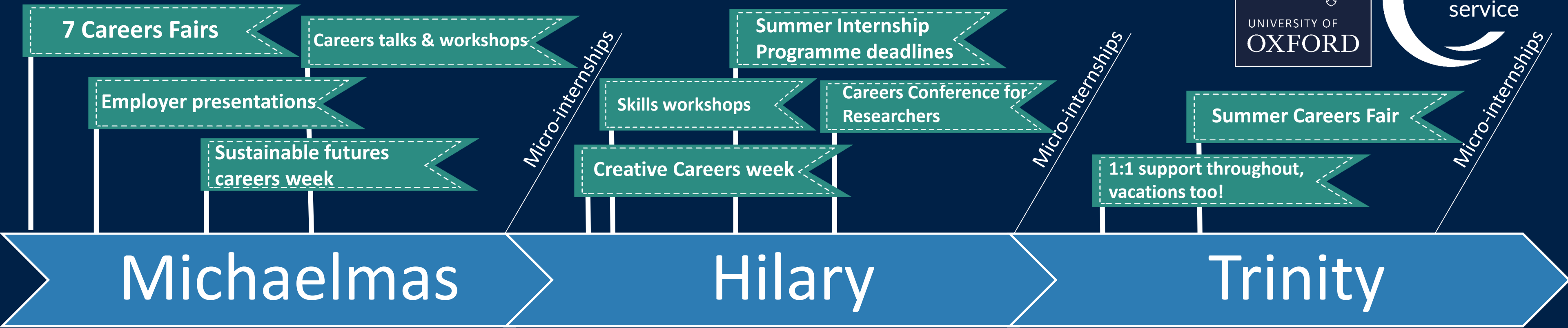


Careers term by term



- Talk to recruiters at Careers Fairs, employer presentations and other careers events
- Application deadlines for some sectors from late October (eg Banking, Civil Service, Management Consultancy, US scholarships for further study)
- Follow target organisations on social media
- Attend relevant career workshops and talks
- Some applications for internships, insight days and spring weeks open
- Perfect your CV and application documents
- Book a 1:1 with a careers adviser if you need help

- Continue making applications and attend interviews
- Explore and apply for internships both with external organisations and through the Summer Internship Programme
- Attend skills workshops (eg assessment centres, interviews) and other careers events
- Make further study applications
- Talk things through with a Careers Adviser if you need support

- Keep on track academically and invest enough time to do yourself justice in finals or any exams
- Keep an eye out for graduate schemes re-opening with additional places
- Many job opportunities available all year round so don't worry if you are not yet sorted.
- Explore job and internship opportunities that are still available on CareerConnect
- Careers Advisers are available to support you throughout the summer if you need them
