Privacy Notice

How we use your data

The personal data you provide on this form will be used by St Edmund Hall to process your donation in accordance with our contractual and legal obligations, and to meet our legitimate interest of alumni and supporter engagement, fundraising and stewardship. We will use your data to: record information about your giving, including any gift agreements, memberships, or correspondence relevant to your donation; communicate with you about the impact of your donation and other appeals that may be of interest to you; update your contact details and communication preferences; record your preferences regarding the external reporting of your donation; and record information about your willingness and capacity to support our charitable objectives.

Who has access to your data?

The data you provided will be shared across the collegiate University of Oxford, including its clubs and societies, in accordance with the University's policies and procedures via our shared relationship management system. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data at any time. The University and participating colleges are both "data controllers", meaning you can contact either the University or your college if you have questions about your data. We may also need to share your data with third-parties supporting the processing of your transaction, and working on our behalf to assist with our communication strategies (e.g. mailing houses, printers). We will only do this in appropriate circumstances, for specified purposes, by secure means, and with the relevant data sharing agreements in place. We do not and will not sell your data.

How long we keep your data

We consider our relationship with our alumni, donors and supporters to be lifelong and we will retain most of your data indefinitely unless you request otherwise.

Your rights

You have the right to opt-out of direct marketing at any time. You also have the rights to request access to and correction or erasure of your data; to request transfer of your data to another party; or to object to the processing of your data or request that such processing is restricted.
