Alicia Stallings is an American poet and translator who lives in Athens, Greece. Her books include *Archaic Smile* (1999), winner of the Richard Wilbur Award, *Hapax* (2006), winner of the Poets' Prize, *Olives* (2012), a finalist for the National Book Critics Circle Award, and *Like* (2018), a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize. She has translated Lucretius's *De Rerum Natura* as well as Hesiod's *Works and Days*, and her new selected poems, *This Afterlife*, has just appeared with Carcanet.

Stallings studied Classics at the University of Georgia before earning her Masters here at Oxford in 1992. She won a Pushcart Prize, the Eunice Tietjens Prize, the Howard Nemerov Sonnet Award, the James Dickey Prize, the Willis Barnestone Translation Prize, among many others. She has also received a prestigious MacArthur Foundation "Genius Grant" for her work on poetry and translation.
